WHAT IS DRUG AWARENESS?

Drug awareness is an important aspect of understanding how drugs are used and misused, their effects, consequences, and legislation. By educating oneself on this topic, individuals can help prevent and reduce drug use and addiction, as well as recognize signs of drug usage. Additionally, learning about the science behind drug use and addiction can provide valuable insight into how drugs affect the body and mind. Some behavioural signs of drug abuse may include: increased aggression, changes in attitude, lethargy, depression, dramatic changes in habits, involvement in criminal activity. Some physical signs could include bloodshot eyes, dilated or constricted pupils, abrupt weight changes, problems sleeping, skin changes and dental issues.
